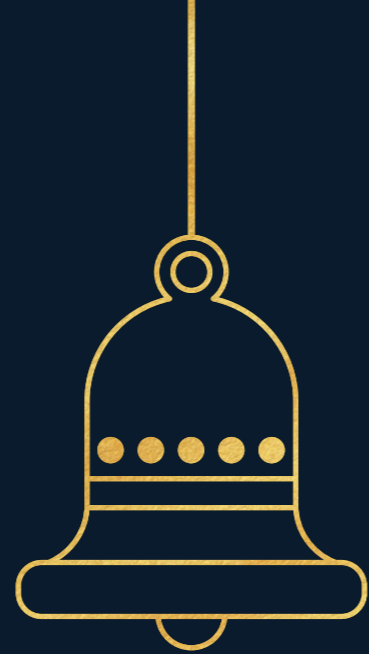
Welcome to Christmas
